Finally, we are very sorry to say, Mrs Hargreaves will be leaving us in June. She has taken on a new challenge, working in different schools alongside many different children, to support their learning. Whilst, her smiling face, amazing work and great team spirit will be a great loss to Beckwithshaw, we wish her well in her new role. Up until summer, we have arranged for Miss Ashleigh Miller, a staff member at Kettlesing Felliscliffe, to work in Class 2 during the mornings. After summer Miss Ash will then work in Class 2.
